This is World History. We will cover the emergence of man, the rise of civilizations, ancient cultures, and medieval times. This course will require that you take accurate notes, write using proper conventions, and read independently. There will be several graded document based essays, or DBQs, vocabulary quizzes, 10 unit tests, and 4 quarterly Exams. Homework is given weekly and students are expected to keep a detailed notebook portfolio that is turned in the day before each Unit Test for grading.
